The process could take several days to even weeks to complete.

FSMB began using DocuSign eSignature a few years ago, but it was time to expand and integrate with existing IT platforms. "As we began to leverage DocuSign more, we came to realize that it could replace portions of our existing portal technologies that we developed in house," recalls Dugan.

Transforming the user experience

Documents are now completed faster and more efficiently than before. What took several days to complete, can now be done in a few minutes.

FSMB has reduced costs associated with paper by about 50%, and the user experience is completely transformed. "With our API integration, transaction completion happens in real time. We can just pop up a window in the API, they click thru and sign it, and then come back into our application. It's nice to have an 'in-app experience'. We don't have to send them to a different site," Dugan explains.

FSMB is completely satisfied with its DocuSign solutions and looks forward to expanded application. "We think DocuSign provides a great value for the cost and continues to add features and functions, which means we can add more value to our clients and customers," Dugan concludes.
