The DHS spends the most money on paper-only forms of any federal agency.

Paperwork is costing DHS more than you think.

Ranking among all federal agencies:

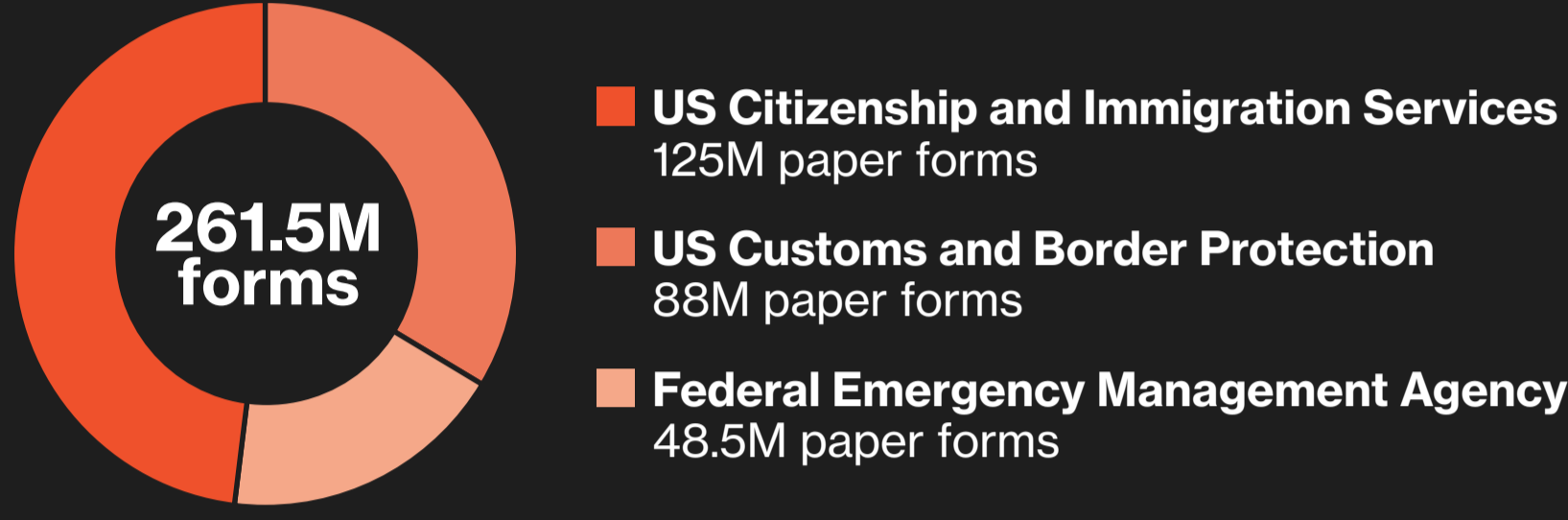
#1 Paper-only paperwork spend' **\$3.1B** per year

#6 Public burden cost **\$3.8B** per year

#8 Paperwork volume **2.3B** forms per year

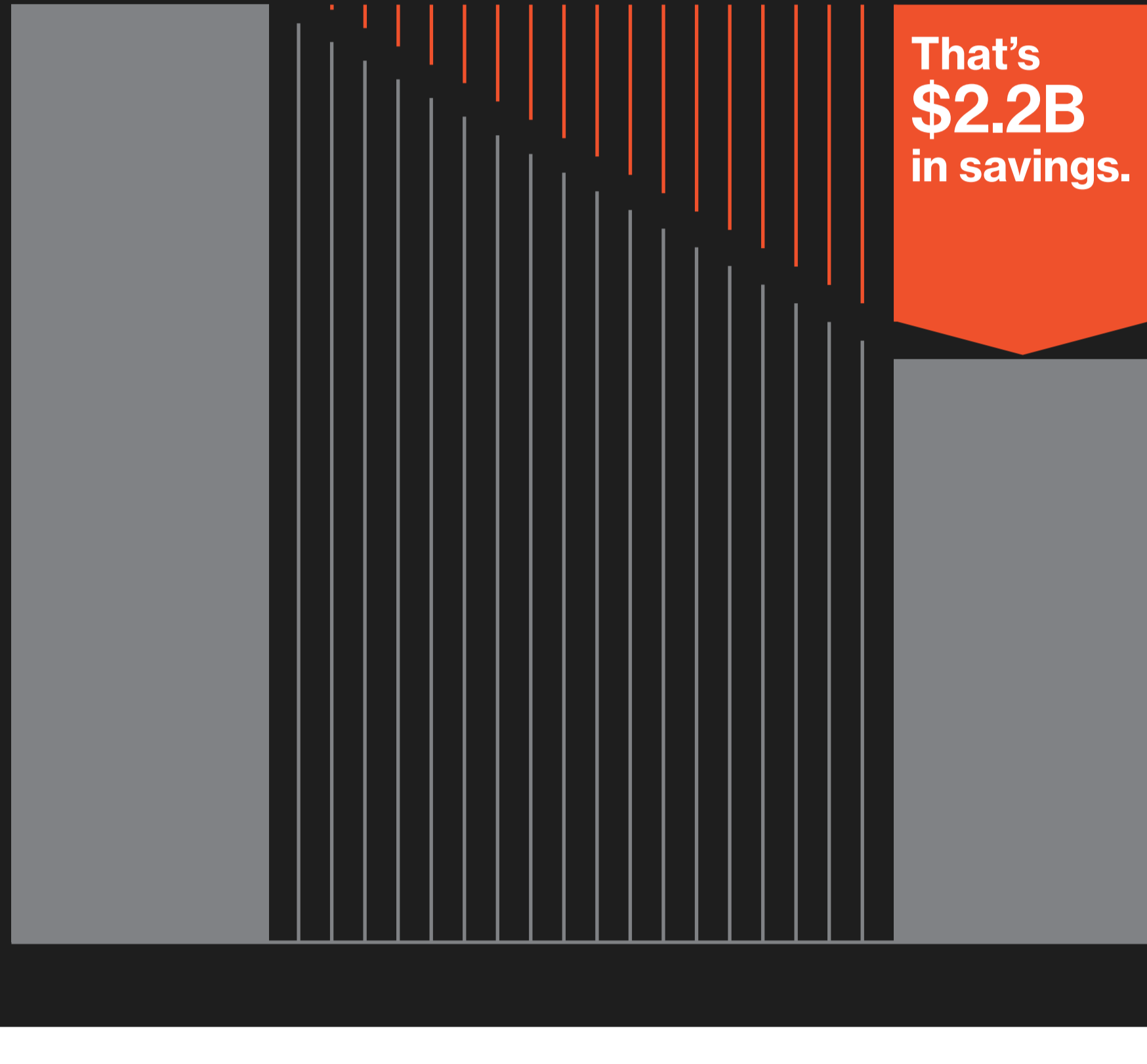
Start by digitizing paper processes and save \$2.2B.

The DHS processes 261.5 million paper forms per year, with the vast majority by three agencies:



261.5M paper forms cost **\$5.9B**

...but digitized could cost **\$3.7B²**

Integrated Digital Experience Act

Voted into law in December 2018, 21st Century IDEA greatly improves the public's digital interactions with the federal government. It establishes deadlines for federal agencies to provide modern, mobile, and accessible government websites, digital forms and services, and electronic signatures.
